There is lack of knowledge and competence in SUD treatment practice; SUD is not incorporated in office-based treatment of substance use disorders and so is underutilized across the Military Healthcare System MHS. Statistical data with MHA / DHA shows 95% of physicians have little or no familiarity with Buprenorphine as treatment for chronic pain and addiction.

- 8. Recognizing the Significance of a Biopsychosocial Approach in attempting to understand the patient with a substance use disorder
